EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

2023 was a breakout year for our team as we exceeded our own decidedly lofty goals. Our record number of exclusives and original news reports caused the most impact of any year in the history of our organization. Our reporting prompted multiple congressional hearings, kept multiple public officials accountable, prompted policy changes and was even the impetus behind proposed legislation at both the federal and state levels.

- For the third year in a row, our development team exceeded revenue goals by double digits. In 2023, we saw a 19% increase over 2022 revenue numbers. This has set us up for another stellar year in 2024.
- Last year, we exceeded our goal of published news articles by posting 10,742 articles, a substantial increase over the 6,453 articles posted in 2022.
- Our stories were republished or cited nearly 2,500 times per month in print and online news sites, television and radio.
- We expanded our Investigative Group, adding a full-time researcher and a senior investigative editor. These changes allowed us to increase the number of deep dives our reporters were able to accomplish. Please refer to the impact section in this report.
- We added significant depth to the <u>training program</u> of the fellows attending our <u>American Journalism Institute</u>, adding meaningful field trips and "lunch and learns" with iconic public figures. Our fellows went to Capitol Hill to meet with congressional members and staff and attended networking receptions. Former presidential candidates Vivek Ramaswamy and Doug Burgum addressed the fellows in on-the-record sessions. Oklahoma Governor Kevin Stitt, author Amity Shlaes, economist Steve Moore, former Maryland Governor Bob Ehrlich and many other high profile industry experts spoke at our lunch and learns.



 Graduating fellows launched their careers, with the most notable, Regan Reese, becoming the White House correspondent at our sister organization the Daily Caller.

OUR PROGRAMS

- Developing and launching the careers of a new generation of non-liberal reporters through training in the <u>American Journalism Institute</u>.
- Our <u>Investigative Group</u> performs long-term investigative reporting, breaking exclusives that have changed the national narrative, exposed the truth and held public officials accountable.
- Policy Reporting that is not automatically pro-government and anti-market.
- Our Video Program: <u>Video Newsclips: In Their Own Words</u> shares short, pithy sound bites on what media hosts, celebrities and lawmakers say on TV, radio or in congressional hearings.
- <u>Big Tent Ideas</u> is our opinion journalism program that expands the reach and impact of center-right thinkers during this crucial moment in our culture and politics.

1. Our Investigation Into Fulton County District Attorney Fani Willis' Corruption Scandal

It all started when Fulton County District Attorney Fani Willis defiantly claimed she paid all outside lawyers involved in the prosecution of former President Donald Trump the same hourly rate. Reporter Katelynn Richardson obtained billing statements showing that

just wasn't true. In fact, special counsel Nathan Wade, Fani Willis' former lover, was billing significantly more per hour than Georgia's top RICO expert.

We continued to break news on this unfolding scandal. Willis's former lover Nathan Wade bought her an airline ticket while he was earning hundreds of thousands of dollars from a lucrative county contract she gave him. So we got our hands on her financial disclosures. Turns out, Fani didn't disclose that airline ticket.

We also <u>broke the news</u> that Willis spent county funds on a firm to monitor her media coverage, just days before she announced her probe into former President Donald Trump. Despite all this, some Fulton County commissioners thought it's a good idea to give her office a massive budget bump.

Impact: Our story went viral and was picked up by dozens of national media outlets including the New York Post, MSN.com and dozens of other major media outlets, generating further investigation of the district attorney. More

importantly, Wade resigned from the case after a judge, referencing our reporting, skewered him and Willis for their ethical lapses. The judge ordered Willis or Wade to step off the case, and Wade fell on his sword. Now, Georgia lawmakers are investigating Willis' actions.

2. Phil Lenczycki's Exposé On Chinese Service Centers Operating In U.S. Cities Generated Lots Of Activity On Capitol Hill

Impact: Several GOP lawmakers were quick to alert the FBI to our story's findings. Ten GOP Senators sent a letter to the DOJ, demanding answers on what it knows about these so-called "service centers." Separately, eight GOP senators sent a letter demanding the FBI and DOJ launch an investigation. The Missouri attorney general launched an investigation that is still ongoing. Phil's story also generated two pieces of legislation, one of which was included in the report of the

defense spending bill passed in December.

3. EXCLUSIVE: Chinese Parent Behind **Company Building Michigan Battery Plants Employs 923 Chinese Communist Party** Members

Impact: First, two former ambassadors <u>wrote</u> a letter to the Treasury Department's foreign investment arm, called CFIUS, to review Gotion's plans to build a battery plant in rural Michigan. Then, Republican lawmakers followed up with the Treasury Department, also asking for CFIUS to review the project. Momentum only built from there. The issue really caught fire with Michigan conservatives. The end result was democracy in action. Most of the township board was voted out of office over the Gotion deal.

Impact: This was another viral moment for the DCNF. Americans and congressional members were stunned at this photo of an agent fist bumping an immigrant crossing the southern border - after the border agent cut the wire himself!

This footage went everywhere and went wild on social media. Fox's Jesse Watters picked up the clip. Even Sky News Australia ran with it.

6. ProPublica's Top Donors Also Bankroll Activist Groups Targeting Justice Clarence Thomas

Impact: We were the only media outlet that thought to look into the finances of the leftwing groups attacking Justice Thomas. It turns out, many of the 'ethics experts' quotes that ProPublica relied on for comment on in its Thomas hit pieces belonged to groups that were funded by ProPublica's biggest donors. A follow-up piece revealed that most of the "ethics experts" ProPublica quoted were also large Democrat donors.

5. Our series on a blue state that's become ground zero for open borders

Impact: Articles from this series were picked up by 128 media outlets in 12 countries around the world. In response to our reporting, Maine's bipartisan congressional delegation <u>sent</u> a letter to the DOJ, pressuring them for answers on this serious issue. The Wall Street Journal even <u>cited</u> our work on the situation in Maine.

7. Series On Illegal Immigration Surging At The Northern Border

Impact: We'd seen <u>reports</u> that the northern border was absolute chaos, so we sent Investigative Reporter Jennie Taer to see for herself. It was chaos, and it was even worse than we realized. Even in the dead of winter, border agents and locals told us people were still pouring in from Canada in order to take advantage of the Biden administration's lax border policies. Our findings <u>prompted</u> a major congressional hearing.




8. American Colleges Are Partnered With Palestinian University That Praised Hamas As 'Righteous Martyrs'

Impact: Robert Schmad found that several American universities had partnerships with a pro-Hamas university in the West Bank. After our report, the University of Georgia let us know they had <u>ended</u> their partnership with the Palestinian university.

9. Series On How Woke Ideology Is Affecting Our Military Including Our Military Preparedness

Impact: Our exclusives on these issues resulted in so much measurable impact, it can't all be listed in this report. Our work prompted congressional hearings and a lot of public outrage. Our articles generated a defense bill that suspended a navy recruiting program that platformed using a drag queen, prompted a defense bill that gave parents greater oversight over pentagon schools, prompted a defense bill cracking down on DEI military spending programs and, finally, students for merit based entry sued a naval academy over race based admissions practices we exposed in an exclusive investigative story.








FINANCIAL: BY THE NUMBERS



Every year, we complete an annual review on each of our existing programs. We critique program quality, impact and reach. Thanks to the significantly increased overall funding we received in 2022 and again in 2023, we continued to expand existing programs and put into place a vision for 2024.

Of note, at least 78% of our expenses went directly to our five programs in 2023. Most expenses and funding were allocated to the <u>Investigative Group</u> and the <u>American Journalism Institute</u>.

We expanded our coverage to include more relevant articles on ESG (environmental, social and governance) policy, religious intolerance, culture and social issues and the military. We expanded our legal coverage to cover the courts, law and criminal justice.
